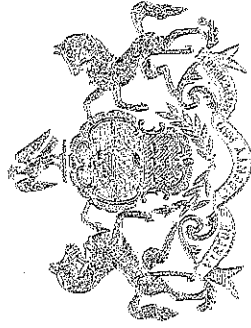

HEALTH, WEALTH AND WELLNESS DAY

September 22, 2010

WHEREAS, In keeping with the goals of the Pennsylvania Department of Health's Office of Health Equity, "Health, Wealth and Wellness Week" highlights available community resources, including on-site assistance, training, interviewing, activities and community-business networking to promote improving health, wealth and wellness status and opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health's Office of Health Equity is working with academic institutions, community based organizations, state agencies, health partners, providers and others in the public and private sectors to achieve its primary goal – to eliminate health disparities in Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, Office of Health Equity educates, trains and mentors minority health care professionals who aspire to become health services executives, and its advocacy includes empowering underserved and underprivileged populations; and

WHEREAS, through education, information and community participation, "Health, Wealth and Wellness Week" underscores the commitment of individuals and organizations in our communities to enhance the quality, access and availability of health care services; and

WHEREAS, "Health, Wealth and Wellness Week" further increases the visibility of participating businesses, vendors, organizations and faith-based entities.

THEREFORE, I, Edward G. Rendell, Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, do hereby proclaim September 19-26, 2010 as HEALTH, WEALTH AND WELLNESS WEEK and September 22, 2010 as HEALTH, WEALTH AND WELLNESS DAY in Pennsylvania.
